SUBJECT: New Onsite Wastewater Practitioner Training Dates

You have been asked to be notified of upcoming training dates for the Onsite Wastewater Practitioner Training Program. Successful completion of this training program fulfills the classroom component of the training required to work in the Onsite Wastewater Industry in BC. This program is also recognized in Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba under the New West Partnership and the Agreement on Internal Trade. Students will be required to complete an online training prerequisite prior to attending the classroom sessions.

The Onsite Wastewater Practitioner Training Program is currently a nine day in-class course and a one-day field training class.

- You must complete all prerequisite training and nine days of classroom training with a passing grade of 75% on all training components in order to receive certification.
- You must also complete a mandatory Site and Soil Evaluation Field Training Day. This is the tenth day
 of training and will be scheduled throughout the installation season. Fees for the Site and Soil
 Evaluation Field Training Day are included in the tuition fees.

The next available training session is a hybrid class and students can choose to attend either virtually on the Zoom platform or in person in Kamloops, BC.

The next dates are:

Days 1-5: Monday to Friday, March 10 - 14, 2025 Days 6-9: Monday to Thursday, March 24 - 27, 2025

If you are interested in participating in the next scheduled session, please complete the registration form which follows and email it back to the WCOWMA-BC office. Upon registration for the class, a non-refundable deposit fee of 25% of the training cost will be charged to reserve your seat and to cover training materials and administration costs. Your course supplies will be sent to you for review prior to training. A minimum class of fifteen paid participants is required for the class to take place.

Training fees must be received in our office prior to the course start date. Cheques may be mailed to the Western Canada Onsite Wastewater Management Association of BC (WCOWMA-BC), PO Box 36086, Victoria, BC V9A 7J5. Visa, Mastercard and e-transfers are also accepted. Please contact our office for details.
